

IDs and Documentation

Scenario: Your student does not have identification and/or adult documents.

These documents are needed for transitional services, programs and various agencies.

STEPS TO OBTAIN A SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

Social Security Card- <http://www.ssa.gov>

In order to get a social security card you will need picture Identification (ID) from your high school or the Dept. of Motor Vehicle (DMV)

*Social Security Cards should be kept in a safe place (do not laminate) and the number should be memorized.

STEPS TO OBTAIN A STATE ISSUED PICTURE IDENTIFICATION

*Picture Identification from high schools are very important.

Dept. of Motor Vehicles (cost \$28.00) plus you must prove your identity with a birth certificate, etc.
